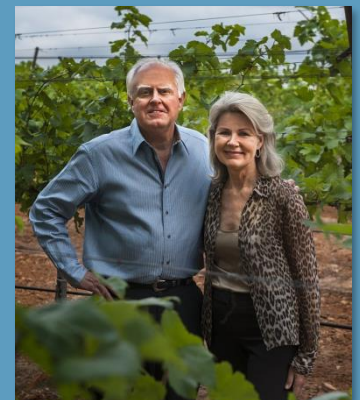

YOUR WINE HOSTS

Ed and Susan Auler founded **Fall Creek Vineyards** in 1975 after an extensive trip to the wine regions of France. Called, "the First Family of Texas Wine", they have worked for 46+ years to build a viable Texas wine industry. Susan was recognized by "Wines & Vines" magazine as one of the Top 50 people in the wine world, and Ed used his legal expertise to draft early laws to allow a Texas wine industry. In mid-1980s, Andre Tchelistcheff became the initial Fall Creek wine consultant. Susan and Ed founded the Texas Hill Country Wine & Food Festival in 1986 to publicize the Texas Hill Country as a known wine region/appellation, and Ed's application to the U.S. government for the Texas Hill Country AVA was granted in 1990. Sergio Cuadra, Fall Creek's Director of Winemaking, applies his talent, unleashing the terroir to reveal the art of small-batch, iconic Fall Creek wines with top scores and reviews by international sommeliers.

A sixth generation Texan, **Ron Yates** spent many summers in Spain and discovered a love for wine. In 2007 together with his family he bought Spicewood Vineyards, an established winery having been first planted in 1992. In 2012 they started **Ron Yates Wines** from scratch. **Glena Yates** grew up on a ranch in Southern Oklahoma that her family had owned since Indian Territory days. She and her husband Ronnie Yates, a fifth generation Texan, settled in the hill country where they raised their two children, Ron and Kara. After Ronnie's death in 2018 Glena became more active in the family wineries and vineyards and presently serves as President Elect of the Texas Wine and Grape Growers Association. Together with an outstanding team, Ron and Glena have produced award winning wines that are considered some of the best in Texas.
